The Dogs SA BLACKHAWK Winter International 2024



The Dogs SA Winter International Committee will conduct four All Breeds Championship Shows over the four days of the Event, with each show having unique requirements. To assist exhibitors, especially if you are entering the Event for the first time, we have prepared the following information which should make entering and understanding the requirements for each show easier. Most of the information is also available on the Dogs SA website and Social Media platforms.



Thursday 30th May: All Breeds Championship Show

This Show is run under the standard Dogs Australia format, using the Alternate System, with the only difference being that some of the larger groups are split between two judges.



Friday 31st May: Dogs SA / Dogs Australia / F.C.I. C.A.C.I.B. Show

Under the Dogs Australia / FCI Agreement of 2017, C.A.C.I.B. Shows in Australia are slightly different to overseas. Therefore, you will need to be familiar with the rules for the conduct of a C.A.C.I.B. Show in Australia. *Please refer to the Information briefs on Page 9-11 for full details*.



Saturday 1st June: Crufts Qualifying Show.

Each State in Australia has a nominated Show which is a Cruft's Qualifying Show for overseas entrants. In South Australia, the nominated Show is the Saturday of the Winter International. To gain the qualification you must be awarded either the Dog CC or Bitch CC or be awarded first place in either the Junior Dog or Junior Bitch class. Qualifying certificates will be emailed on request following the Show in pdf format. Please refer to the Cruft's website for full details for overseas entrants.



Sunday 2nd June: F.C.I. Asia, Africa and Oceania Champion Title (A2O) Show

The Sunday of the Winter International is approved as an official FCI A2O Show and is eligible to award A2O CAC's. The A2O CAC's are awarded to the Best Dog and Best Bitch and follows the Dogs Australia Rules with regard to the Best Dog and Best Bitch. 2024 Winter International Judge Resumes





1: Mr Zaur Agabeyli (Azerbaijan)

Together with his wife, Zauer Agabeyli started breeding West Highland White and Cairn Terriers and had some success with these breeds. Since 1999 he has bred Dobermanns under his own kennel name "v. Feuer

Stamm" and imported several successful dogs in Azerbaijan. For the last few years Mr Agabeyli has bred German Shepherds and has in his kennel both working and show line dogs. Mr Agabeyli has been judging since 2006 and is an FCI All Breeds Judge.



2: Mr Mel Saranchuk (Canada)

Mel and his wife Lynda have been showing and breeding since 1974 under their Hysteppin Kennels and whilst English Setters remain their primary passion, they have also owned and exhibited Labradors, GSPs, Siberian Huskies, Irish Wolfhounds and Standard Poodles. He has

judged in all over Canada and overseas in Argentina, Bermuda, China, Colombia, New Zealand, USA, and Australia.



3: Mrs Lynda Saranchuk (Canada)

Lynda and her husband Mel have been showing and breeding since 1974 under their Hysteppin Kennels and whilst English Setters remain their primary passion, they have also owned and exhibited Labradors, GSPs, Siberian Huskies, Irish Wolfhounds and Standard Poodles. She

has judged in all over Canada and overseas in Argentina, Bermuda, China, Colombia, New Zealand, USA, and Australia.



4: Mr. Preetham Thukaram (India)

Preetham Thukaram started showing dogs at a very young age as a Junior handler with Great Danes. Later on, with his father, he started exhibiting and breeding Whippets, Labradors and German Shepherds. He has exhibited and/or bred several other breeds including Dobermans,

Pugs, Fox Terriers (Smooth), Afghan Hound. An All-Breeds Judge, he has judged in all parts of India and overseas in China, New Zealand, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Costa Rica, Japan and different states of Australia.



5: Mrs Sumiko Ikeda (Japan)

Mrs. Ikeda, an All Breeds and FCI All Breeds Judge, from Japan, was raised in Yokohama, where her family bred and raised American Cocker Spaniels. She began showing American Cocker Spaniels and Miniature Schnauzers in 1979 and has bred many Champion American Cocker

Spaniels, English Setters, Lakeland Terriers and Miniature Schnauzers. Mrs. Ikeda has officiated at shows throughout Japan, USA, Asia and Australia.



6: Mr Mitsunori Terada (Japan)

Mr Terada comes from a dog family and was raised with Dobermann, Boxer, Pointer, Boston Terrier, Cairn Terrier and many other breeds. Around 1969 his father began breeding British Bulldogs and he went to Shows with the Bulldogs and his mother's Shih Tzus. A Handler of many

breeds, he focused on the breeding of Bulldog, Shih Tzu, French Bulldog, and bred many champions. Following his retirement as a handler, Mr Terada focused on judging and has enjoyed many appointments around the world.



7: Mr Takio Kamei (Japan)

Since he was born into a family which bred and showed Akita dogs, he became naturally interested in dog shows. Back then in Japan, the TV series "Lassie" was extremely popular attracting him to Collies. The joy and excitement

of having his own Collie as a member of the family still stays with me. Later on, he saw Shelties at a show and literally fell in love with them and has been for more than 30 years. In 1980, he owned his first Sheltie (sable female) and in 1982, bred his first Shelties. In 2006, he earned his first judging license for the Herding group and since then has been active as both judge and breeder, qualifying for more breeds.



8: Mr Gopi Krishnan (Malaysia)

Gopi Krishnan studied for 9 years in the UK and this gave him the opportunity to attend dog shows every weekend. His Hacienda Kennels have owned, coowned, campaigned (owner exhibited) and titled

150+ Champions in Std. Smooth, Std. Longhaired & Min. Longhaired Dachshunds, English Setter and English Cocker Spaniels, with many homebred. Gopi joined the MKA judges training scheme in the 1990's and has judged all over the world at many of the top shows.



9: Mr Al Ferruggiaro (USA)

Mr Ferruggiaro's interest in purebred dogs began as a teenager by handling his black Miniature Poodle, in Junior Showmanship. His interest continued into adulthood with breeding and exhibiting dozens of AKC champion Lakeland and Norwich Terriers. The AKC has

approved Al to judge all 32 Terrier breeds as well as an additional 80+breeds. He judges Terriers regularly throughout the US. Additionally, he has judged Terriers in Australia, Canada, China, Japan, and New Zealand.



10: Mr Adrian Landarte (Uruguay)

Adrian Landarte started in the world of dog shows at age of 17, when he bought his first Afghan Hound. From that moment he got involved more and more in this hobby as breeder, exhibitor, judge, organizer, and director. With Jorge Nallem they founded "El Retorno" kennel having

great success breeding Irish Setters, Beagles, Schnauzers, Dachshund, Fox Terriers, Whippet, Greyhound and Cimarron Uruguayo. Adrian is an all-breed judge and began his career as an Irish Setter judge in 1987. He had the pleasure of judging in more than 50 countries of all continents.



11: Mr Jorge Nallem (Uruguay)

Owner of "El Retorno" Kennel, Jorge Nallem breeds Standard Schnauzer, Wire and Smooth Fox Terriers, Whippet, Beagle, Boxer, Short hair Dachshunds, Greyhound and Cimarron Uruguayo.

He became a Fox Terrier judge in 1987, and an All Breeds FCI judge in 1996. Specialist judge on Old English Sheepdog, Boxer, Doberman, Schnauzers, Fox Terriers, Basset Hound, Irish Setters, Poodles, Shih-tzu and Afghan Hound. Jorje has extensive international experience, judging in many countries around the world.

FCI Asia, Africa & Oceania Champion Title (FCI A20 Ch.)

The Dogs SA Winter International Committee is excited to announce the Winter International Championship Show on Sunday 5th June 2022 is approved as an official FCI A20 Show and is eligible to award A20 CAC's. (Challenge Certificates)

Many FCI countries around the world award 'Regional Titles', for example in the FCI Americas Section there are regional titles such as Pan American Champion and Latin America Champion. The regional Australian FCI title is the Asia, Africa & Oceania Champion, in the short form FCI A20 Champion (FCI A20 Ch.), which came into effect 17th June 2019.

Due to the structure of the ANKC and the way individual States Bodies manage and run their own affairs, dispensation is given to Australian exhibitors to qualify for FCI A20 Section titles, in that A20 CAC's won in different countries be replaced with individual States counting as different countries.

Requirements to attain Asia, Africa & Oceania Champion Titles in Australia:

To obtain the title of Asia, Africa & Oceania Champion: A dog/bitch who is already an Australian Champion or Champion of an FCI member country, must win FOUR A20CS CAC's dog/bitch at any FCI A20 Championship Show (A20CS) organised by any of the ANKC State bodies or approved Clubs within the State. To obtain the title of Asia, Africa & Oceania Grand Champion: A dog/bitch who is already an Australian Champion or Champion

of an FCI member country, must win **EIGHT A20CS CAC's** dog/bitch at any FCI A20 Championship Show (A20CS) organised by any of the ANKC State bodies or approved Clubs within the State. At least TWO of the Eight A20CS CAC must be won in different States of Australia.

To obtain the title of Asia, Africa & Oceania Supreme Champion: A dog/bitch who is already an Australian Champion or Champion of an FCI member country, must win TWELVE A20CS CAC's dog/bitch at any FCI A20 Championship Show (A20CS) organised by any of the ANKC State bodies or approved Clubs within the State PLUS win a BIS1 (Best in Show 1) at an A20CS. At least THREE of the twelve A20CS CAC must be won in different States of Australia.

Awarding of A20CS CAC's

The A20CS CAC's are awarded to the Best Dog & Best Bitch OR Dog CAC & Bitch CAC at a Championship Show. The Show does not have to be a CACIB/International Show and the awarding of the A20CS CAC's follow the ANKC Rules with the regards to the awarding of the Best Dog & Best Bitch OR Dog CAC & Bitch CAC.

The Winter International Committee is delighted to have on their 2024 judging panel several senior members of the Africa, Asia and Oceania Section hierarchy including section Vice President Mr Gopi Krishnan, who will judge Best in Show at the 2024 A2O Championship Show.



Winter International CACIB Show INFORMATION TO EXHIBITORS

Order of Judging

Breed Level

- The order of judging is as follows
 - a. DOGS
 - Baby Puppy Dogs For dogs aged three months and under six months (not eligible for CACIB)
 - Minor Puppy Dogs For dogs aged six months and under nine months. (not eligible for CACIB)
 - 3) Puppy For dogs aged six months and under twelve months (not eligible for CACIB)
 - 4) Junior For dogs aged nine months and under eighteen months (not eligible for CACIB)
 - 5) Intermediate For dogs aged eighteen months and under thirty-six months (a CACIB may be awarded)
 - 6) Open For dogs 15 months and over that are not Champions (a CACIB may be awarded)
 - 7) Champion To enter a dog in Champion Class, the title must have been confirmed by the issue of a Registered Pedigree Certificate with the title added by the day of the official closing date of entries; a Champion that has not attained 15 months of age may not be awarded a CACIB
 - 8) Veteran For dogs aged 8 years or older (not eligible for CACIB)

b. Challenge/CACIB

- 1) All class winners from CLASSES .2 21 are eligible for the ANKC Challenge and are to enter the ring
- 2) The judge selects the Challenge winner from those dogs in the ring. Should the Challenge winner be eligible for the CACIB (Intermediate, Open, Champion over 15 months and awarded excellent then they will automatically be awarded the CACIB.
- The second placed dog from the class of the Challenge winner then enters the ring.
- 4) The judge selects the Reserve Challenge winner. Should the reserve challenge winner be eligible for a CACIB then if the Challenge winner was not eligible it will be awarded the CACIB.
- 5) Should neither the Challenge or Reserve Challenge winners be eligible for the CACIB then if any of the class winners were eligible they then remain in the ring for the judge to award the CACIB from those eligible only.
- c. Bitches Repeat steps 1a and 1 b.
- d. Best of Breed
 - Best of Breed judging is conducted in the normal manner for the Alternate judging procedure which is Best and R/U Best of Breed followed by only Baby Puppy and Puppy Classes. Best in Group and Best in Show judging is judged in accordance with the current regulations for the Alternate method. That being Best in Group 4, 3, 2, 1, followed by Baby Puppy and Puppy. Similarly, Best in Show is judged 2, 1, followed by Baby Puppy and Puppy

On the occasion of its online meeting on 3-4 September 2020, the FCI General Committee decided to create two new International Beauty Champion Titles <u>for all dogs of breeds (subject to a working test or not)</u> entered in <u>Junior</u> (<u>from 9 to 18 months</u>) or <u>Veteran class</u> (<u>from 8 years and over</u>) at FCI International CACIB Shows in accordance with the <u>Regulations for FCI Dog Shows</u>:

C.I.BJ	International Junior Beauty Champion (Champion International de Beauté Jeune)
C.I.BV	International Veteran Beauty Champion (Champion International de Beauté Vétéran)

The BASIC requirements for ALL pedigree dogs are:

	International Junior Beauty Champion (Champion International de Beauté Jeune)

We would like to draw the special attention of the FCI Members and Contract Partners to the following:

- the <u>exceptions regarding the judges & number of countries</u> granted to the Asia, Africa & Oceania (A2O) / American & Caribbean (A&C) Sections <u>approved by the FCI General Committee for the C.I.B.</u> <u>titles</u> will also be taken into consideration:
 - → A2O & A&C: one (1) single country is enough, but 3 different judges AND 3 different nationalities are required;
- all applications for the C.I.B.-J and C.I.B.-V titles must be sent to the FCI Head Office by email (<u>champion@fci.be</u>) <u>EXCLUSIVELY through the NCO</u>. The use of the official FCI form ENCLOSED is <u>compulsory for this kind of application</u>;
- the dog must be <u>entered in the catalogue of the show</u> and <u>a copy of the cards</u> handed to the exhibitor at the shows indicating that the relevant dog has been proposed for the "1st Excellent" in Junior or Veteran class <u>must be ENCLOSED TO the application</u>.

The FCI Regulations for the International Championship will be amended accordingly and sent later.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT THE C.A.C.I.B. SHOW

1: What Age does my exhibit have to be, to be eligible for the C.A.C.I.B.?

Fifteen (15) months is the minimum age to be eligible to be awarded the C.A.C.I.B.

2: What Classes are eligible for the C.A.C.I.B.?

Intermediate (5/5A), Open (11/11A), Champion (21/21A) (Effective 1 April 2024)

3: My Dog is a Champion but under 3 years of age, do I have to enter the Champion Class?

NO, you may enter any age eligible class or the Champion Class. The only Class a Champion may not enter is Open which is for NON-Champions only, over 15 months. NOTE: A Champion in another country, even if not titled in Australia, is deemed a Champion for the purposes of what class to enter.

4: Can I be awarded the C.A.C.I.B. from the Junior or Veteran Classes?

NO, dogs 15 < 18 months can compete in either the Junior or the Open/Champion Classes. If they compete in the Junior Class, they can receive a CACIB-J but not a CACIB. If they compete in the Open/Champion Class, they can receive a CACIB but not a CACIB-J. The same principle applies to the Veterans (CACIB-V).

5: How is the Veteran Class judged?

The Veteran Class is judged as an ordinary class and the winner of the Veteran Class will compete for the Challenge Certificate. The Veteran Class should be judged between Junior and Intermediate. NOTE for the FCI Show, the age for Veteran is 8 years and over.

6: How are the Challenge and C.A.C.I.B. AWARDS judged?

The Challenge Certificate is awarded first. Should the Challenge winner be eligible for the C.A.C.I.B., they will automatically be awarded the C.A.C.I.B. This is followed by the awarding of the Reserve Challenge Certificate and Reserve C.A.C.I.B. Certificate if eligible. If a dog from one of the classes (Puppy, Junior or Veteran) which is not eligible for a CACIB wins the Challenge Certificate, the Reserve Challenge Winner, if eligible, can be awarded the C.A.C.I.B. The two challenge winners will then compete for Best of Breed.

7: Will there be separate Group Specials for the 10 FCI Groups?

Yes, as per the November decision by the FCI, groups can no longer be combined in Australia, so all 10 Group winners will compete in General Specials for Best in Show 1st, Best in Show 2nd, Baby Puppy and Puppy.




